

How Do I Enroll?

You will receive login information from your Kootenai Clinic Cancer Services care team which will give you access to your Online Patient Portal. See instructions within.

Can my family access my Online Patient Portal?

Yes, you can give family members, such as parents, children or health care proxies, access to the Online Patient Portal.

Is My Information Safe?

Yes. Online Patient Portal passwords are encrypted and the webpages are designed so that the information cannot be copied and pasted. You and authorized family members are the only ones who can access your Online Patient Portal. Also, a timeout feature protects your information if you leave the page open.

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What is the Online Patient Portal?

The Online Patient Portal, SeeYourChart™, is a convenient and secure health management tool you can use anywhere you have access to the Internet. Through the Online Patient Portal, you can:

- View a summary of your clinic visits, as well as the ability to verify your personal information
- Access education resources on your diagnosis and treatment
- Access your medical information from the comfort of your own home
- View lab and imaging reports once they have been released by your physician
- Share medical information with your family or caregiver
- Print out information for your records or for your primary care physician
- Secure messaging to and from the Cancer Services nursing team
