# MIRALAX/GATORADE/BISACODYL PREP INSTRUCTIONS

#### **BEFORE YOU BEGIN**

Purchase the following medications over the counter (no prescription needed)

- Miralax 238g (8.3 ounces)
- 4 bisacodyl 5mg Laxative Pills (Dulcolax brand or generic okay)
- Two 32-ounce bottles of Gatorade (NO RED, BLUE OR PURPLE)

# DAY PRIOR TO TEST

- Take 2 bisacodyl 5mg tablets at 7 am and 2 additional tablets at 7 pm
- NO solid food ALL DAY
- Start strict CLEAR LIQUID DIET, if you are diabetic, monitor your blood sugar. For low blood sugar drink a sugared clear soda like Sprite or 7-up.
- Nothing RED, BLUE OR PURPLE

AT\_\_\_\_\_ ON \_\_\_\_\_

- Mix HALF of Miralax powder with the 1st 32 oz bottle of Gatorade in a large pitcher. Stir until completely dissolved. Drink an 8 oz glass of the solution every 15 minutes until you finish the mixture.
- If you develop cramping, bloating or nausea while drinking the preparation, you should stop drinking for about a half an hour. Then you can resume drinking the solution. The diarrhea will usually continue for several hours after completing the bowel preparation.

### DAY OF THE TEST

- Mix the other HALF of Miralax with the 2nd bottle of Gatorade. Drink an 8 oz. glass of the solution every 15 minutes until you finish the mixture.
- Continue clear liquids until 4 hours before your test. At this point, you must stop all liquids including water, gum, candy, mints, and cough drops. Also includes NO chewing tobacco for 8 hours prior to test.

# CLEAR LIQUID DIET:

- Coffee or tea with any sweetener no creamer
- Clear fruit juices-apple, white grape or white cranberry
- Gatorade, other clear bottled drinks
- Any clear carbonated soft drinks- (7-UP, sprite, etc.)
- Clear broth Chicken, beef or vegetable
- Jello: orange, lemon, lime, pineapple or peach (nothing added)
- Water

#### It is very important to drink as much fluid as possible to prevent dehydration and to help the Laxative work!

#### DO NOT DRINK ANY LIQUIDS AFTER \_\_\_\_\_\_
