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Statement of Candidate for election to the Kootenai Hospital District Board of Trustees:

My name is Chris Nordstrom. I have been a resident of Kootenai County for seven years since retiring from the Capital Group Companies (parent organization of the American Funds). In my 22 years with that organization I provided technical and engineering solutions for various information technology initiatives including providing guidance and advice to the executive board in making decisions and developing budgets on many large scale IT projects. As Assistant Vice President, Collaboration Engineering, I led a team of technicians, engineers and analysts in completion of a multi-million dollar project to upgrade the telephone system to a unified voice over IP (VOIP) system with over 15,000 end-points, supporting 10,000 employees in 22 cities around the world.

After graduating from Charter Oak High School in Covina California, I attended Pasadena City College in the Associate of Arts program studying business prerequisites. I also studied a curriculum of aircraft and airborne technology in the Associate of Science program at the Community College of the Air Force.

After serving six years in the United States Air Force as an avionics technician and trainer, I studied business administration at the University of Phoenix and then an online course at St. Leo University, Florida.

I am a licensed amateur radio operator having attained the highest license level of *Amateur Extra* granted by the Federal Communications Commission. Through my amateur radio activities I am able to provide service to my community through various volunteer opportunities.

I am very excited to be able to provide even more service to my community by running for election to the Board of Trustees of the Kootenai Hospital District. Through an advise and consent roll on the board, I will strive to make sure that we in North Idaho have the best, most compassionate medical care anywhere, through the hospital's mission to ***"...improve health one patient at a time in a friendly and professional culture committed to superior quality and safety."***
